The Town Board and Planning Commission are initiating the update of the long-range land use plan, referred to as the Town of Mukwonago Master Plan. Initially prepared in 1981 and last updated in 1998, the Master plan is a tool to help guide future land use and development in the Township. It is our intention to create a plan that is in conformance with the recently adopted Wisconsin Comprehensive Planning and Smart Growth Law.

The Town Board and Planning Commission seek to involve the public in the planning process to the greatest extent possible. The first step we are taking in this process is to solicit the opinions of every household in the Town of Mukwonago on such issues as the importance of preserving the rural character, the rate at which the Town should grow, preserving the rights of property owners, and the types of land uses that are important to the future quality of life.

Your responses will guide the preparation of the new Smart Growth Master Plan and help us recommend policies and regulations that respond to the citizens of the Town of Mukwonago.
