Minutes of May 9, 2013 meeting

- 1) Meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by Chairman Miller. Present: Chairman Karl Miller; Commissioners Gail Yerke, Robert Maus, and Lyle Boucher; Attorney John Macy. Also present: Chief Czarnecki, Sergeant Schmidt.
- 2) Election of officers – Chairman Miller asked Commissioner Yerke to conduct the meeting for the purpose of electing a Chairman. Maus nominated Karl Miller for the position, Yerke seconded. Passed 4/0. Miller assumed the Chair and asked for nominations for Secretary. Maus nominated Lyle Boucher, Yerke seconded. Passed 4/0.
- 3) Status of Officer Heckman:
 - a) Officer Heckman stated at a previous meeting that his charges against Chief Czarnecki and Sergeant Schmidt were advisory to the Commission, and not a formal Complaint. Following review of a considerable volume of material submitted by Heckman, the Commission did not find cause to initiate charges. No action taken.
 - b) Officer Heckman's concerns regarding sick leave and administrative leave were previously held (4/1) to not meet the criteria as discipline, and therefore do not come under the jurisdiction of the Commission. No change from previous posture.
 - c) The matters that were articulated by Officer Heckman are appropriately pursued through the Union grievance procedure.
 - d) Motion by Boucher that the Commission defer action until Union and any other processes are complete, and then become involved only where shown by Statute, precedent, or ruling that the Commission has jurisdiction. Seconded by Maus, passed 4/0.
- 4) Chief Czarnecki sought authorization to develop a list of potential candidates for part-time positions. Motion by Maus, seconded by Yerke to grant that authority. Passed 4/0.
- 5) Motion to adjourn by Maus, seconded by Yerke. Passed 4/0 at 8:19 PM.
